Grill Guard Installation Guide

5045E, 5055E, 5065E & 5075E with the 520M loader.

Required / suggested tools:

Spring clamps
Wrench or socket wrench

Below is the process for installing the 511 grill guard on your tractor.

- 1) Remove the 4 front carriage bolts from each side of the upper and lower crossbars. Retain the hardware.
- 2) Place the 511 grill guard onto the factory brush guard frame from the front side.
- 3) Align the holes on the flanges of the 511 guard with the holes in the sides of the factory guard.
- 4) Reinstall the four carriage bolts that were removed during step 1 on each side and install the washers and nuts. Do not tighten the nuts at this time.
- 5) Position the 511 guard to your liking and clamp in place. Spring clamps work well to hold the guard in place. It is recommended to leave a small gap between the 511 guard and the crossbars of the factory guard.
- 6) Tighten each of the four carriage bolts.
- 7) Installation is now complete.
